- ☐ **Nov 3: Teacher Connection:** Families contact one teacher to express appreciation or ask about student progress.
- ☐ **Nov 4: Family Tech Talk:** "What's one thing you're proud of this week?" to strengthen communication.
- ☐ **Nov 5: Family Movie Night:** Watch a film about perseverance (e.g., *Hidden Figures* or *Stand and Deliver*) and discuss lessons learned.
- ☐ **Nov 6: Reflect & Share:** Students journal or share one insight about communication they learned this week.
